On your way home

- ★ Install multiple locks on the door.

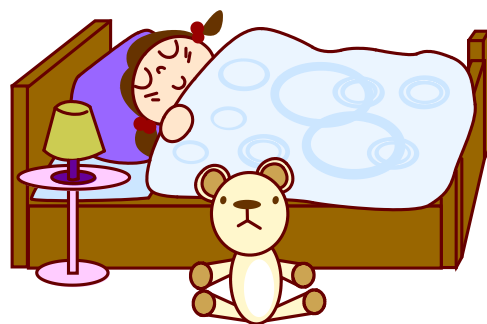
Before going to bed
