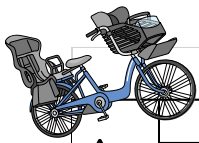


# The relaxation of the age limit for a child that a cyclist can carry in child seat of a bicycle began.



Now a cyclist can carry a child that has not yet started elementary school on a bicycle. Before the relaxation, cyclists were allowed to carry only children under 6 year old.

(Ordinance for Enforcement of the Road Traffic Act No.1 of Article 9 was modified.)

**Wear a helmet.**  
Make sure that you have your child wear a helmet which fits their heads.

**Size of the child seat.**  
Use a child seat that fits the child's body.
